A NEW BOGLIASCO FOUNDATION/BARYSHNIKOV ARTS CENTER JOINT RESIDENCY

The Bogliasco Foundation and Baryshnikov Arts Center (BAC) are pleased to announce a new joint residency that will offer Dance, Music, and Theater Fellows the opportunity to bring work developed in Bogliasco to a wider audience and bigger space in New York City.

Joint Fellows in the performing arts disciplines will benefit from a month-long residency at the Bogliasco Foundation's Study Center in Italy to nurture and develop new projects, followed by a week-long residency at BAC in New York City to rehearse, workshop, and showcase these works-in-progress.

The Joint Fellowship is a collaboration between two respected international non-profit organizations with the shared mission to support the creation of new work in the arts. Traveling from the intimate spaces and cross-disciplinary community at the Bogliasco Study Center to the lofty studios and well-equipped spaces at BAC will take Fellows on a natural progression in the development of their creative work.

The first Joint Fellow will begin his or her residency in Bogliasco in Spring 2017. For this term, all applicants to the Bogliasco Foundation in the disciplines of Dance, Music, and Theater will be considered for this special Fellowship. The deadline for applications is April 15, 2016.

About the Bogliasco Foundation: Located in the fishing village of Bogliasco near Genoa, Italy, in a region of extraordinary beauty whose landscape has stimulated creative expression for centuries, the Bogliasco Foundation offers one-month residencies to individuals of all nations who can demonstrate notable achievement in the Arts and Humanities. The Foundation awards 50 Fellowships per year, and in 20 years of operation has hosted over 850 Fellows from 55 countries.

About Baryshnikov Arts Center: BAC is the realization of a long-held vision by artistic director Mikhail Baryshnikov, who sought to build an arts center in New York City that would serve as a gathering place for artists from all disciplines. Supporting artists is central to BAC's mission. BAC hosts up to 30 residencies a year, providing dance, theater, music, and multimedia artists with the space and resources to research and develop new projects and collaborations.
